WINEMAKING:

Aduentus Mediterraneo 2014 is a complex blend of three wines made from grapes carefully selected from high-elevation vineyards in the Uco Valley, one of the world's most desirable growing areas. Malbec contributed its silkiness and luscious fruit, Tempranillo enhanced structure, and Syrah added spice. Because our winery's gravity-flow technology ensured unusually gentle treatment of the fruit, each base wine was bursting with fresh varietal flavor before being blended into this exceptionally smooth and harmonious wine.

TASTING NOTES:

"The appealing plum and cherry character of this ruby-red blend is immediately apparent on the nose, along with back notes of tobacco and camphor. Hints of cocoa and spice come through on the palate and persist through a lingering finish."
