### WINEMAKING

Sun-drenched days and chilly nights in Antigal's finest and highest-lying vineyard allowed the Malbec grapes used for this limited edition single- parcel wine to ripen slowly, intensifying color and aromas. Minimal handling and cold temperature winemaking at our winery protected the integrity of the fruit. After 22 months oak-aging, the wine was poured into uniquely designed, individually numbered bottles.

### TASTING NOTES:

"The finished wine has a bright color: an intense purplish-red tinged with blue. There is great aromatic complexity, with notes of plum, raspberry, strawberry, chocolate, vanilla, cinnamon and tobacco. On the palate the wine has good balance and volume, its structure benefitting from the presence of firm yet silky tannins."
